What is Special About Cat Boarding at St. Louis Cat Clinic

Cat comfort and security are goals when our patients stay with us.

All cats are provided with a size appropriate space, a cat bed, soft towels, blankets, or quilts. Shy cats are provided with a box to hide in or a cage door cover to help facilitate their security. The clinic has a large selection of cat toys for enrichment and entertainment. Toys are exchanged periodically so that something new is available for our curious feline friends.



Cages are cleaned daily. Disposable litter boxes are used. Toys are washed between use. All boarding cats are fed and cleaned twice a day and anytime in between as needed. Staff members cherish their own cats and interact with the cats who stay at the clinic on a daily basis.

St. Louis Cat Clinic will board client's cats that require medication, subcutaneous fluids, or insulin daily.

Our clinic cat's antics often provide entertainment for the boarding cats pleasure. Staff members pass by frequently to rub and talk to all of the cats. Stimulation and compassionate care is our standard. The clinic has some cats that board frequently that will go directly to their usual cage and ask to get inside.
